ASK in advance

The hepatitis C (Hep C) test is not part of routine blood work. So call your doctor before your next appointment to have the Hep C test added to your lab order.

S

SPEAK with your doctor

Be clear about why you want to be tested. Print this page and take it to your appointment, so that you'll have these important facts with you.

- 1 in 30 Baby Boomers (people born 1945–1965) has Hep C, and most don't even know it
- Many people can live with Hep C for decades with no symptoms
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that all Baby Boomers get a one-time test for Hep C
